



## Terms and Conditions for Ayurveda Cooking Workshop

### 1. Booking and Payment

- **Workshop Fee:** The total fee for the Ayurveda Cooking Workshop is £170.
- **Deposit:** A 50% deposit (£85) is required upfront to secure your place.
- **Balance:** The remaining balance of £85 must be paid by **1st November**.
- **Non-payment:** If the balance is not received by 1st November, your place in the workshop may be forfeited without a refund of the deposit.

### 2. Deposits and Refunds

- **Non-refundable Deposit:** The deposit is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- **Transferable Deposit:** If you are unable to attend the workshop on the booked date, the deposit can be transferred to a future workshop, provided that you notify us at least **7 days in advance**. Rescheduling requests made within 7 days of the workshop will result in the forfeiture of the deposit.
